



# GETTING AROUND in POZnan\*



City transport is generally good, majority of buses and trams is quite new and cosy. Time tickets are adopted – spanning 15, 45, 90 min, 24hrs and 7days

Short time visitor can use **paper tickets** to buy at vending machines at stops – a ticket has to be validated once, immediately after entering the first bus/tram:




You can **pay by card/phone** as well, when already in the bus/tram. Touch the screen, choose language and ticket time (for Normal tariff) and go on with payment. In case of ticket **control**, use the **same card you used for payment**. **The orange**

**terminals (not pictured) at the doors are for urban cards only!**

**Routes and timetables may alter due to numerous road repair works after frosty winter, but try the suggestion below for getting around during our meeting:**

- 1) from the main station (Poznań Główny) to the “Vivaldi” hotel:
  - tram nr 10 from stop at Głogowska street just in front of western exit (Dworzec Zachodni)
  - bus nr 168 from station central square (called Dworcowa street)
- 2) from the “Vivaldi” hotel to our conference room in Collegium Cieszkowski
  - bus nr 182 from stop “Słowiańska” (at the north side of viaduct over tram line) 5 stops to stop “Wojska Polskiego”. But you have walk ca. 10 min from the hotel to the bus stop.
- 3) from the “Vivaldi” hotel to the Old Town
  - tram nr 4 to “Plac Wielkopolski” for the Old Market, or stop further to “Małe Garbary” to cross a bridge and get to the Cathedral

Each stop has it’s name (which may be ambiguous) and it’s unique code: there several stops called “Słowiańska”
